ADDITIONAL COMPETITION EXPECTATIONS & REMINDERS

Out of courtesy IPA do arrange a Staff On Duty to assist dancers/parents, be there for moral support and to help should an emergency arise. As it's not a compulsory competition set by Industrie, the following is a reminder to parents and clarifying some 'additional comps' expectations.

The following applies to additional competitions only.

- We encourage our dancers to enter additional competitions, however it is not compulsory and is ultimately a commitment made by the parent and dancer not the individual teacher.
- You should always check with your solo teacher to see if they think the dancer is ready for such competitions and does depend on dance experience, age and workload.
- Staff On Duty is not responsible for soloist's music. Parents are responsible for their own music. You should have a copy of their music all year through (not a good idea to burn new C.D's just before a comp as they sometimes don't work, it's a good idea to check cds in your car CD player) it is also your responsibility to register your music at the competitions – they are all different so read the rules carefully.
- All competition rules are different. Please read them carefully. It's really important to know how they each work.
- Have a copy of your music AND a back up on hand at all times.
- Teachers should not be expected to take your soloists for a rehearsal pre-performance. The guided rehearsing obligations end once lessons in the studio have finished. It is up to your dancer to have a practise should they not feel ready, not your teachers responsibility and we expect you are entering these competitions stage ready!. Of course, at times we do run the dancers, however it is not essential.
- It is important to remember that parents have entered their dancers as and 'additional' stage experience. Ensure you and your dancer are ready and capable of experiencing competition life without a teacher necessarily at your disposal. All dancers know how to prepare themselves for a performance and may just need to be guided by parents.
- Staff On Duty may not always be familiar with all students, we will try and remember to post who is on duty and ask that parents/dancers make themselves known to the teacher so they can ensure they are not left behind. Staff will do the same.
- We ask parents to take photos and forward to the office/IPA so we can celebrate your dancer and their effort.
