CONCERT INFORMATION

- **Concert rehearsals** as per our IPA handbook, concert rehearsals are compulsory and essential to a professional show. Please lock those dates in your diary and note that a detailed rehearsal schedule (outlining when and what time you are required) has been sent out last week of Term 3 in our concert booklet
- **Concert tickets** will be on sale from Thursday 19th October (ticket sale information available in the concert booklet).
- **Concert t.shirt** samples will be at DV the first week of Term 4 only, to try on for sizing. Concert t.shirts are compulsory for the concert finale for all students. Payment and order through Miss Ali or Bellerive reception.
- **Jacket orders** You are still able to order Industrie jackets. Jacket costs are \$73 for kids and \$83 for adults – includes printing costs & gem.

VERY IMPORTANT INFORMATION ***PLEASE READ***

- **Fee changes.** There are some important fees changes effective in term 4. All information has been emailed out last week of term 3 please let me know if you have not received this.

Congratulations firstly to my ever so capable dancers who competed in Launceston Festival of Dance & Follow Your Dreams over the school holidays. You did this on your own without your support crew standing side stage cheering you on. This is a huge achievement on its own and I am very proud of you for stepping out in your IPA jackets and representing our studios.

Secondly thank you to those competing students and my dance families for allowing me the down time I needed with my family. Dance, this school & my students are a huge part of my life and have been my life since I can remember.

A mental and physical break was just what I needed to return fresh and rearing to go for some of my favourite people in the world. All ready for concert season! Whoop Whoop!

Whilst I only teach 3 days a week in New Norfolk I also teach 5 competitive tap groups on the Eastern shore (9&under, 11&under, 13&under, 18&under & Open group), have a young family & another business to run. Like all families – life is busy.

Dance has given me so much more than just 'dance skills' I've learnt life long skills - I'm confident, have a professional local dance career in shows, musicals, have been modelling professionally and in promotions from the age of 16, made the best of friends and created a career for myself doing something that I LOVE.
